The mission of Catonsville Emergency Assistance (CEA) is to provide neighbors in need in the Greater Catonsville area with emergency food, eviction prevention, utility assistance and service referrals.

Food Assistance

Hunger hurts everyone, but it is particularly bad for children. In Catonsville, 33% of households do not make enough money to fully meet their daily needs. We supply income-eligible neighbors with a week's worth of groceries monthly. In addition, we work with local partners to support homeless individuals in our community.

Utility Assistance

Energy costs can place severe stress on a family's budget, and sometimes the BGE bill just can't be paid. We provide financial assistance to income-eligible neighbors in our service area for utility assistance.

Eviction Prevention Assistance

Families facing immediate court-ordered eviction from their homes, have a limited number of options. We provide resources to income-eligible neighbors within our service area.

589 people in **289 households** received food and other services from CEA



Enough food for over **101,000 meals** was provided to members of the Greater Catonsville community. **This is more than 121,000 lbs of food!**



100 volunteers donated more than **5,300 hours** to make our work possible



85 households received utility assistance and **18 households** received eviction prevention assistance
